# Objective

In this session your students will be challenged to identify, understand, and use the power of God.

# Warm Up

# The Song

#### **Transition**

Break into small groups.

### Bible Study

Go through these instructions:

- Go around and share your name and if you could only have one super power, what would it be?
- What do you think really happens when people allow God's power to work in their lives?
- How would you describe the Power of God—what does it look like?

Read **Colossians 1:16**. Ask: "According to this passage, what is God powerful enough to do?"

Read 2 Peter 1:3-4. Ask:

- According to this passage, why has God given us His power?
- How would you describe God's power in your life?
- What do you think would happen if you took that step of faith?
- How could your home benefit from you becoming a "volcano"?
  What would change in your school if
- you were a "volcano"? 
   How would your friends react to you
- being a "volcano"?
- How would this small group and youth group change if we were all "volcanoes"?

# Wrap Up

Say, "God's power is so real and so awesome. He has given it to us, and He wants us to use it—not to let it just sit dormant inside us. I challenge you to burn bright in the night sky—just like a volcano! Go out and experience His power in and through you!" Close in prayer.
